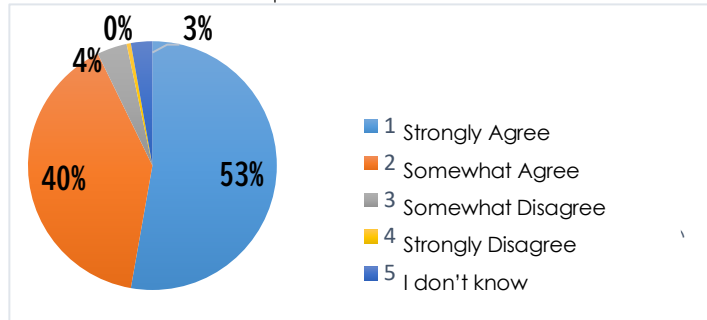


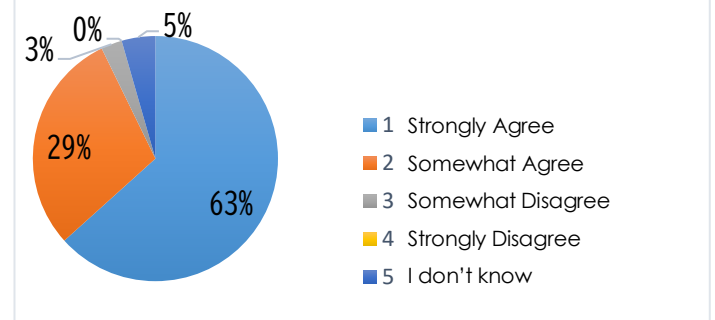
# 2025~26 School Year 1<sup>st</sup> Term School Evaluation Parent Questionnaire Results

## Response Rate 74% (181/237 families and school management council members)

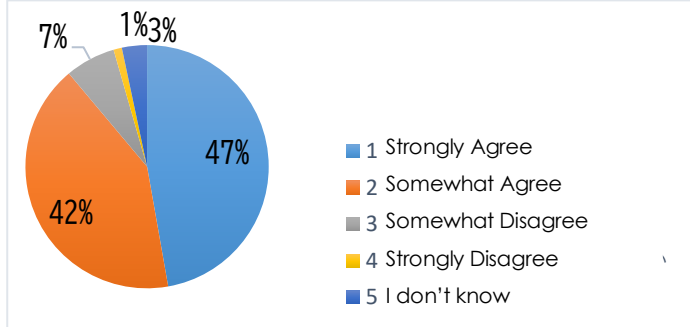
1 The school provides classes where the students can share and express their ideas freely through things such as "learning together" and "acknowledging one another" in order to acquire basic academic skills.



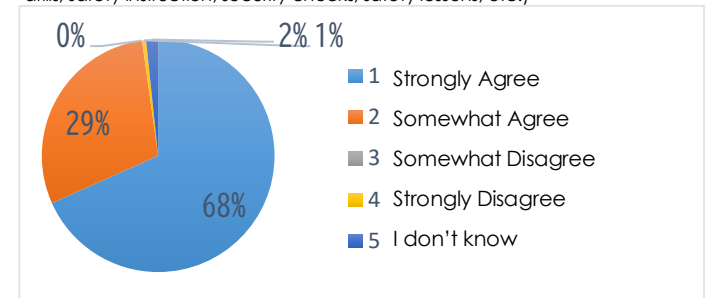
6 The school strives to motivate the students to become familiar with sports and the arts through activities like interacting with athletes (ball-throwing etc.)



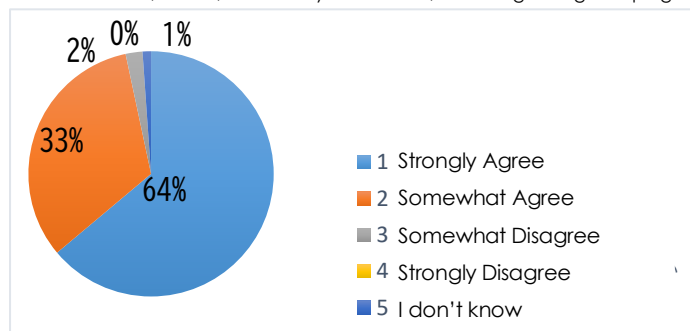
2 The school provides "understandable," "achievable" and "enjoyable" classes (studies).



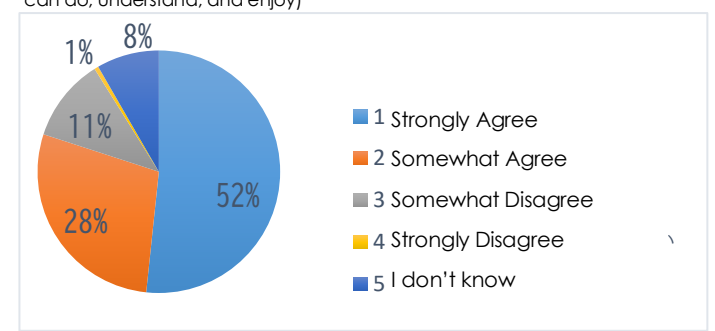

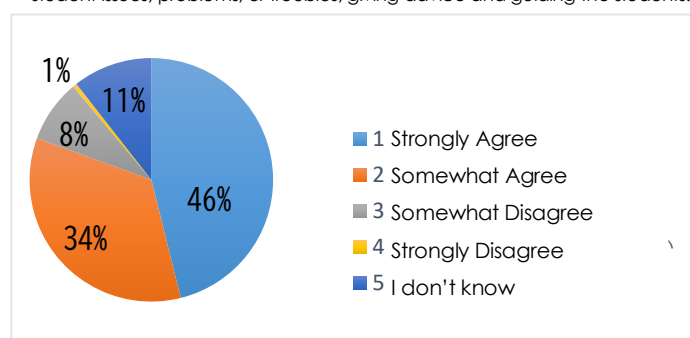

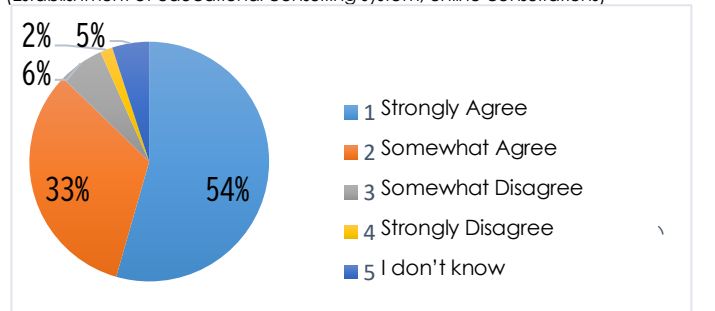
8 The school actively engages in diversifying and enriching guidance and support depending on each student. (Promotion of special support education Everyone can do, understand, and enjoy)



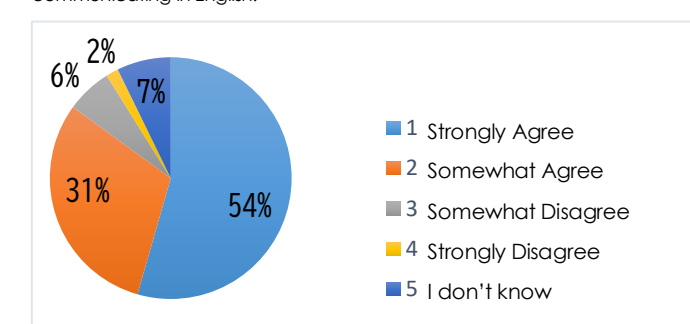
4 The school strives to prevent bullying or truancy by being conscious about student issues, problems, or troubles, giving advice and guiding the students.
