Japanese

- Before learning the process on how to "write" letters, you should do the *Shosha Taiso* warm-up exercises on page 2 and 3 of the *Shosha* textbook. You can view the exercise movie from the textbook's QR code. Please use the videos on the school homepage as a reference for how to hold a pencil and proper sitting posture.  
*Shosha Taiso Steps* P2. 3  
① Push the back of your head against your hands.  
② Pull your fingers.  
③ Push your fingers.  
④ Clench and unclench your hands.  
*Tracing the line* P10. 11  
Be mindful of the ends of the letters, such as 「とめ」 (stop), 「はらい」 (swing), and 「はね」 (hop).  
P12.13  
Be mindful of the parts of the letters, such as 「まがり」 (round), 「おれ」 (corner), and 「はね」 (hop).

- Complete Phonics worksheets 1 and 2 as well as the Name worksheet

Math

- "Using the math set, play number activities using numbers up to 10" ~Please use the video on the school homepage as a reference for how to play the number activities.  
① Prepare 10 math blocks, count while saying the numbers out loud from 1 ~ 10.  
② Count how many times someone at home claps their hands.  
③ Using the picture on the cover of the math set box, place the flat marbles on one type of animal, choose the same dot card or number card.  
④ Roll one dice, choose the same dot card or number card that came out on the dice.  
⑤ Put the dot cards and number cards face down, line them up randomly and play the memory game.  
⑥ Line up (descending order or ascending order) the number cards. When they are lined up turn a few cards over and guess the number.  
⑦ Put the dot cards or number cards face down, you and someone from home each pick a card and turn them over at the same time, the person with the larger number keeps both cards. Lastly, count the amount of cards you have.  
⑧ Take out 4 flat marbles (5~10 are okay too), from those 4, hide a random amount in your hand, guess how many flat marbles are hidden.  
⑨ Using the 10 blocks from math set, slide the lid to cover a few blocks, guess how many blocks are covered.

<p>Life Studies</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Finding Signs of Spring</li> </ul> <p>If you have a chance to take a walk, find signs of spring by looking at the living creatures (insects) and flowering plants along the roadside or in flower beds. If you find signs of spring, write it down in your observation card. Observation cards will be available to print by clicking the Grade1.2 Assignment tab on school homepage. Please choose from either the lined card or blank card when filling out the observation car.</p>
