The results of the Student Questionnaire and the School Evaluation Parent Questionnaire were discussed at the school management council meeting on February 8 (Mon), and I would like to share the results in this letter. Overall, we have received a positive evaluation of over 90%.

On the Student Questionnaire, in regards to their classes, 93% answered that they "Understand well" or "Understand," and "I enjoy speaking in class," and 92% answered that they "Can present to the class with peace of mind," which shows the results of the "Nanzan Style" as a basis for learning. This is also relates to the increased motivation of the faculty.

6% of students gave a negative response when answering the question "Do you enjoy going to school?" We learned that the main causes vary from day to day, and include things like understanding of the studies and relationships with classmates. We will continue to carefully instruct and support the students while building individual relationships with them.

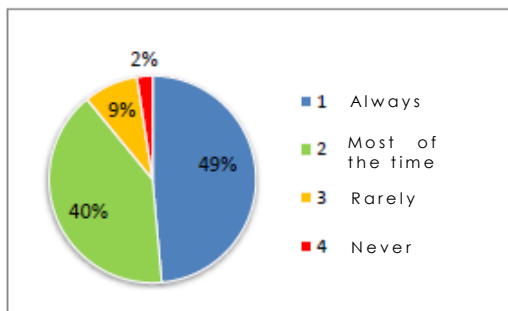
From the Parent Questionnaire, we received the same evaluation as last year, but we believe that insufficient dissemination of information from the school regarding the academic consultation system and special support education is reflected in the results. 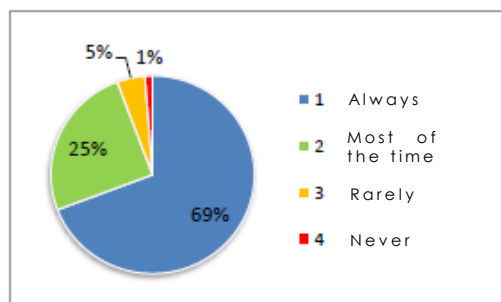

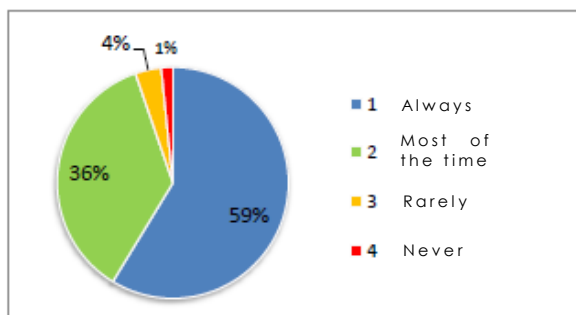
2 Do you share your thoughts and ideas in conversations and presentations in class?



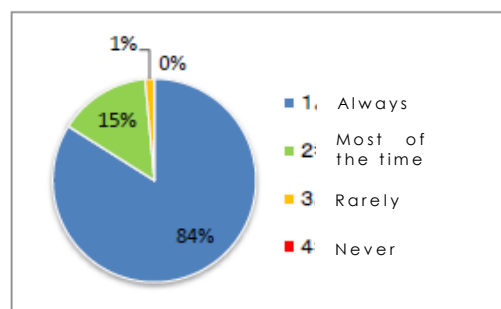
3 Can you enjoy studying by teaching each other and cooperating with your classmates?



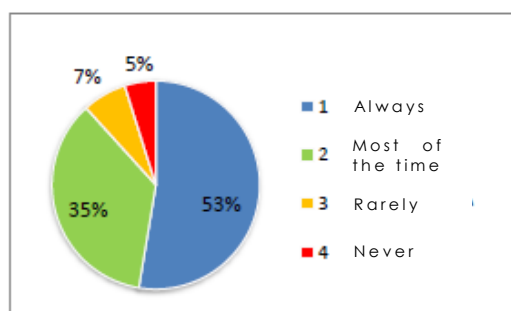
5 If your friends are in trouble, do you try to help?



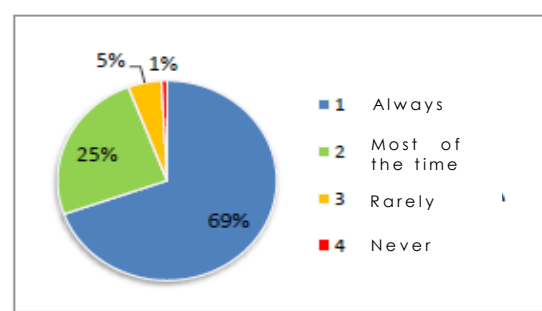
7 Do you believe that bullying is unacceptable behavior?



6 Do you think that you have good qualities?

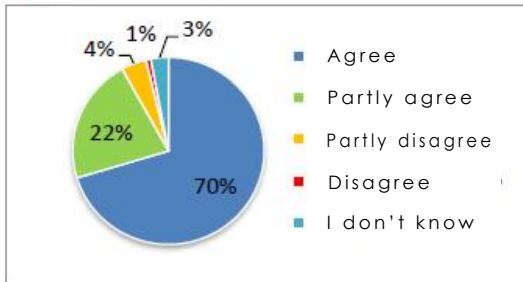


10 Do you enjoy going to school?

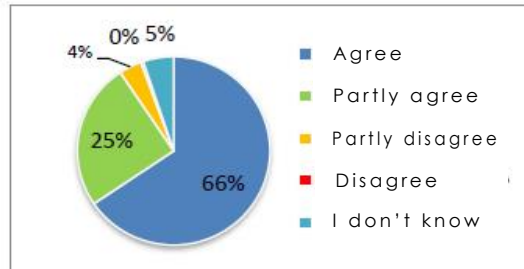


2020-2021 School Year 2nd Term School Evaluation Parent Questionnaire Aggregate Results 96% collection rate (238/249 people)

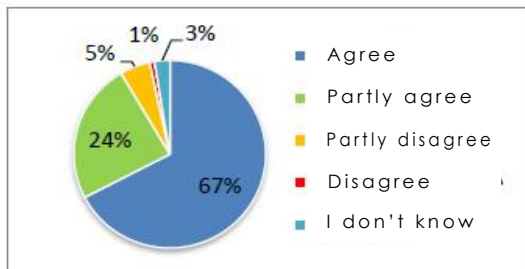
1. The school provides classes where the students can share and express their ideas freely through things such as "learning together" and "acknowledging one another" in order to acquire basic academic skills.



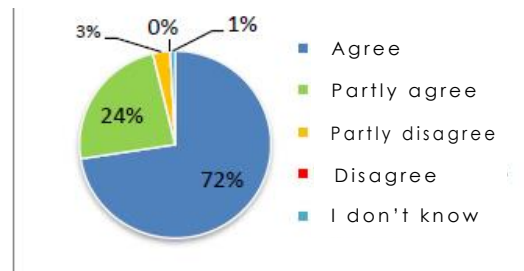
6. The school strives to motivate the students to become familiar with sports and the arts through interacting with athletes and attending music concerts.



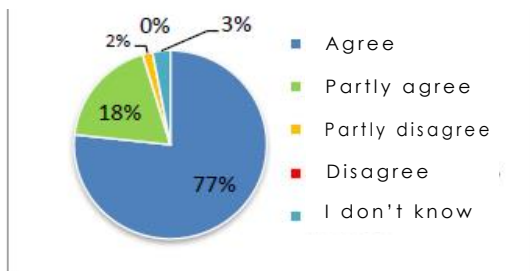
2. The school provides "understandable," "manageable," and "interesting" classes (studies).



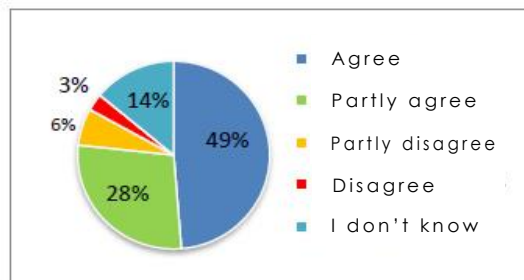

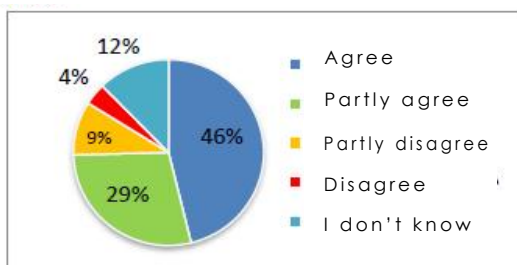

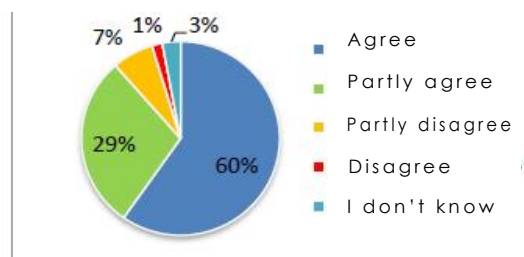
8. The school actively engages in diversifying and enriching guidance and support depending on each student. (Promotion of special support education)



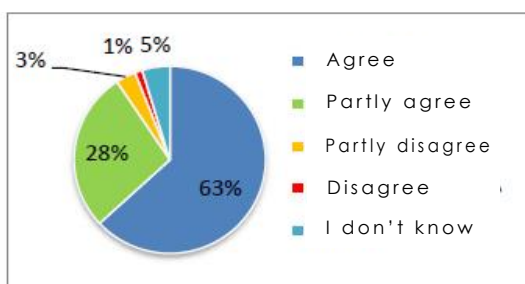
4. The school strives to prevent bullying or truancy by being conscious about student issues, problems, or troubles, giving advice and guiding the students.
